GUIDE International Workshop 2008 is the third of a series of conferences organized in collaboration with the Università Telematica "Guglielmo Marconi" to improve a new cooperation system in the field of Higher Education and Distance Learning within five geographical macro areas: the Americas, Europe, Africa, Asia and Middle East.

The Workshop themes cover many aspects of distance education and training, including e-inclusion and accessibility, digital divide and digital opportunities, sustainable development, knowledge dissemination and social interaction, with the aim to promote digital culture and international research partnerships.

Bringing together academic research and practical application, the GUIDE 2008 Conference analyses ODL systems by comparing the methodological approach and the different experiences of networked universities in online teaching and learning.

The 2008 Workshop gives institutions coming from both Industrialized and Developing Countries the opportunity to analyze the cultural and economic impact in higher education through the presentation of case studies and reports.
